
Printable Ring Size Guide

You can find your size by measuring a ring you own (or one for the intended recipient) using the following methods

Method 1

1. Print this Size Guide Chart on A4 size paper.

To ensure the printed dimensions are accurate, place a credit or any bank card on the rectangle below. If the card fits within the rectangle, the scaling is correct.



- 2. Place a ring that fits you on the circle below to find your correct ring size
 - 3. Ensure that you measure the inner circumference of your ring.



Method 2

- 1. To begin, get a strip of paper or string, a pen, and a milimetre (mm) ruler
- 2. Wrap the paper or string around your finger and mark the overlapping point.
 - 3. Measure the length to the marked spot with the help of the ruler. Note its circumference and refer to the below chart to find the right size.
